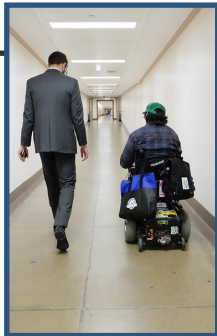
**CONSORTIUM FOR CITIZENS WITH DISABILITIES**
