2007 Ad Hoc Transition Task Force Annual Report

2007 Activities

The Ad Hoc Transition task force formed to develop transition specific recommendations for No Child Left Behind, the Higher Education Act, Title I of the Workforce Investment Act, and Rehabilitation Act (Title IV of WIA). Representatives of the Education and Employment task forces joined the ad hoc group and met and developed recommendations. The recommendations were then sent to the Education and Employment task forces where they were incorporated into the overall recommendations for these specific bills and submitted to the appropriate House and Senate Committees for their consideration. The ad hoc transition task force also provided comments on a Notice of Proposed Priority from the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) regarding Model Demonstration Projects to Improving the Postsecondary and Employment Outcomes of Youth with Disabilities.

2008 Goals and Priorities

Since the recommendations developed by the Ad Hoc Transition Task Force have been incorporated into the work of the Education and Employment task forces, there is no need to continue this ad hoc task force during 2008.
